Site Visit Materials

One month before the site visit, the peer review team received a copy of the [Assurance Argument](#), a 100-page

document prepared by the university to demonstrate the ways in which the university meets each of HLC's five [criteria for accreditation](#).

Peer reviewers are able to access the Assurance Argument within HLC's secure electronic portfolio system, which also gives them access to approximately 9000 pages of supporting materials provided by the university as evidence for the claims made in the argument.
